## Reader Response Ideas

Favorite Part:

- Write about your favorite part of the book and why you liked it. Draw a picture when you are finished writing about it.

Short and Long Vowel Search:

- Find words in your book that contain short and long vowel sounds.

Postcard:

- Write a postcard to someone about your book. Tell them why you liked it and include a picture on the other side.

Character Interview:

- Imagine you are going to interview a character in the book. What are some questions that you would ask? How do you think they would answer the questions?

ABC Order:

- Choose between 10 and 20 words from your book. Write those words in alphabetical order.

Noun Sort:

- Find 15 nouns in your book. Write 5 nouns under each person, place, and thing category on your paper.

New Book Cover:

- Illustrate a new cover of your book.

Bookmark:

- Make a bookmark about your book. On the front, draw a picture that represents your book. On the back, write the title of the book and tell what your book is about.


## Circle Map and/or Bubble Map:

- Complete a thinking map about your book.

Story Flip Book:

- Make a flip book about your book. Write the following on the outside flaps: character, setting, problem, solution. On the inside, draw a picture and write a sentence describing each one.

Book Award:

- Make an award for your book. What is the name of the award? Why does your book deserve the award?


## New Book Ending:

- Give your book a new ending. Draw a picture to accompany your new ending.

Letter to the Author or Character:

- Write a letter to the author or a character in the book. Tell them why you liked the book.


## Predictions:

- Before reading, write predictions of what you think will happen in the book. After reading, write what really happened in the book.


## Punctuation Hunt:

- Find and write examples of the 4 types of sentences in your book: statements, questions, exclamations, and commands.
